1st Aichi Sentrair International Crossing Swim

Date: 24.Sunday.August.2014

Race Events: The Sentrair Crossing Swim will consist of one individual event. The race will use a beach start and beach finish. The course will be (one way straight away) marked with orange buoys.

Location: The race will take place at **Rinku Beach, Tokoname City, Aichi, Japan**

Eligibility:

The race is open to all swimmers. You must be in good health and have some swimming experience in order to participate.

Registration and Entry Fees:

Individual **2km: 10,000JYE** Dinner Function: 4,000JYE

(It includes: swim cap/bus transportation)

Entries must be received by 30.Jun.2014 to ensure entry.

Late entries have 1000 yen surcharge from 1.Jul to 10.Aug.

Age Category: Age for the meet is determined as of 31.Dec.2014

Individual: under18, 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, over80 male and female.

Award

(1) All the competitors will be given the certified diploma with her/his time record.

(2) Medals will be awarded for first to third place in each age group for individual events.

Rules:

■ All swimmers must swim the prescribed course.

■ All swimmers must wear their prescribed cap, race number.

■ A swimmer may not use extraneous aids e.g. flippers, snorkels or floatation clothing devices (including wetsuits) if they wish to be eligible for a prize.

■ If the water temperature is 18C or below on the day of The Swim the Race Referee will permit the wearing of wetsuits. This will not preclude swimmers from prize eligibility.

■ If in the opinion of the Race Referee the weather or swimming conditions are dangerous or unsuitable The Swim may be cancelled without notice

■ The decision of the Race Referee is final. Any protests must be made in writing to the Race Referee within 30 minutes of the completion of The Swim
